We are intentionally working with partners in congregations, schools, businesses, foundations and other organizations to plan, develop, and operate a state-of-the-art campus.

An interdisciplinary, interfaith strategic planning team is currently at work led by Lavon Winkler, CEO of Milbank Manufacturing, to outline a long-term process for building in phases.

Seven acres has already been set aside for development of tent camp and outdoor conference facilities. An amphitheater and band shell will be built with volunteer labor. Other planned short-term projects include a sports pad, prayer garden with columns and a labyrinth, and an 18 hole miniature golf course.
